	The <b>Original passport</b> should be valid for at least 3 months beyond the intended duration of stay in the Schengen territory and with at least two blank page to affix the visa. The passport must have been issued within the last 10 years.
	Copy of <b>previous visas and stamps</b> of the applicant's old passport(s) <i>if any</i> .
	Copy of <b>name or surname change certificate</b> , if applicable.
	<b>Proof of integration:</b> into the country of residence: Copy of household registration record.
	<b>Proof of occupation.</b> - If the applicant is employed: 1) the last three payslips, 2) labour contract or original documents confirming employment at recent date, 3) approval for holidays are required. - If the applicant is a company owner or self-employed: certificate of registrations of the company* and statement of taxes payment are required. - If the applicant is retired: Pension statement is required
	<b>If the applicant is sponsored and/or hosted in a private accommodation:</b> - Invitation/guarantee letter - A copy of passport or national identification card of the sponsor/host in Denmark - If the sponsor/host is a foreigner, a copy of permanent residence permit is also required. - Bank account statements on the turnover during the last three months of the sponsor/host when its/his/her financial means are not proven otherwise.
	<input type="checkbox"/> <b>Certificate from a medical doctor and/or a medical institution</b> confirming the need of specific medical treatment to be received in the destination country <input type="checkbox"/> <b>An official document</b> of the receiving medical institution confirming that it can perform the specific medical treatment and the patient will be accepted accordingly. <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Proof of pre-payment</b> of the treatment <input type="checkbox"/> <b>Any other correspondence</b> between the sending medical doctor and the receiving hospitals, if available.
	<b>Documentation of funds to cover the trip.</b> <i>According to the Danish Immigration Service you must have the <b>necessary means</b> to pay for your stay and return trip. As a general rule, you must have at your disposal approx. DKK 350 per day if you are staying in a private home and your host will cover all costs. If you are staying at a hotel, the amount must be greater, approx. DKK 500 per day. 	<b>Proof of lodging:</b> Hotel reservation, rental of holiday home, campus residence reservation – if not hosted in a private accommodation.
	<b>If the applicant is minor accompanying parents:</b> - Birth certificate of the applicant * - Copies of the ID cards of the parents and guardians. * - If you are travelling with only one of your parents: <input type="checkbox"/> A letter of consent written and signed by a non-accompanying parent and guardian, except in cases of an accompanying parent having sole custody, and <input type="checkbox"/> An original and a copy of certificate of sole custody (if applicable)
	<b>Documentation providing clear information about the trip, including:</b> 1.Round trip reservation/booking Flight/train/ferry reservation with fixed travel dates of maximum 90 days to Denmark and other Schengen countries. <b>(Do not buy the ticket until a visa has been granted).</b>
	<b>Original compulsory travel medical insurance</b> , covering the entire of intended stay, valid for all Schengen countries covering any medical expenses of at least 30,000 Euro as well as urgent medical attention, emergency hospital treatment or death during your stay, repatriation to Vietnam/resident country

**Note:** Official documents marked with \* must be verified by the competent local authority. Verification must be maximum 3 months old. A certified translation in English must be attached to any documents in Vietnamese.
